

FNAM EXPRESSES SOLIDARITY WITH MEDICAL DOCTORS STRIKING IN KENYA

The Portuguese National Federation of Doctors (FNAM) expresses solidarity with Kenyan doctors and other health professionals who protested on the streets on the 22nd of March to demand better wages and working conditions, as part of a national strike that has entered its second week.

Kenyan doctors held up signs and shouted slogans against the Kenyan government, criticizing the fact that it had failed to deliver on a series of promises, including a collective labor agreement signed in 2017, after a 100-day strike during which people died due to lack of healthcare.

FNAM sends union greetings and challenges Union of Doctors, Pharmacists and Dentists challenges to sign the <u>international manifesto</u> in defense of better working conditions for doctors and in defense of accessible, quality public healthcare for all people.
